Present were Ricky Priest, Tye Hunter, Paul Vensil, Tom Graham, John Freas, Officer Marohl, Mayor Wolford, Sam Epply, Zack Guthrie, Sue Graham, Clarence Fracker

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mr Priest

Mr Vensil moved approval of the July 3rd minutes. Mr Hunter 2nd Vote was 3 years

Officer Marohl gave the police report.

Sam Epply, representing Verdantas, updated the values for funding the proposed Old Riley Rd project. There are 2 options with the differences being based on how much cash the township is willing to front. Mr Hunter moved to go forward with the township fronting \$60,239.55 and utilizing the OPWC loan amount of \$121,097.24. Mr Priest 2nd and the vote was 3 yeas. Mr Epply also suggested Trustees explore the CDBG grant applications as well. The Works Wise agreement required by Verdantas was signed by Fiscal Officer.

Mr Graham reported 2nd half real estate settlement receipt of \$134,495.83

Mr Hunter moved to enter a Memorandum of Understanding with Muskingum County Commissioners for the county to assist with any blighted properties within the township. Mr Vensil 2nd Vote was 3 yeas. Resolution #8012025

Trustees reviewed the 2026 proposed Local Government Fund projections at \$11,416.38

Fiscal Officer requested an increase in revenue adjustment and increase in appropriation for the fire district fund in the amount of \$13,509.47 Mr Priest moved 2nd by Mr. Vensil. Vote 3 yeas. Look into

Fiscal Officer reported a request of a possible donation for Mount Zion Cemetery for upkeep and maintenance. Discussion led into agreement to moving forward with questions and information.

Mr Fracker attended offering to donate an unused cemetery plot in Frazeysburg Cemetery back to the township.

Mr Guthrie asked for the list of roads to be chip sealed this year and as to why there had been to official discussion as to said list.

Mr Hunter reported that all hardware and supplies for the road/safety signs has been received and the project can commence. Discussion was held as to speed limit signs and the process for establishing and enforcing speed limits.
