The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mr Priest

Mr Vensil moved approval of the December 30 meeting minutes. Mr Hunter 2nd Vote was 3 yeas.

Mr Vensil moved approval of the 2025 Re-organizational minutes Mr Hunter 2nd vote was 3 yeas

Chief Bourne gave the January police report

Mr Priest moved to certify Twp road mileage at 20.372 miles, Mr Vensil 2nd vote was 3 yeas.

Mr Hunter moved to purchase a new mower for the cemetery, using funds from the Cemetery Bequest Fund. Mr Vensil 2nd vote 3 yeas.

Mr Priest moved to place the cemetery levy back on to the ballot in November. 2nd by Mr. Hunter. Vote 3 yeas.

Discussion was held regarding investing a partial amount of township funds, in particular the cemetery bequest fund. A decision would require inquiring at a few different banks and a resolution drawn up by township legal council.

Members of Frazeysburg Volunteer Fire Department were in attendance to share thoughts regarding rumors of revisiting the Fire District discussion. They stated that a county wide mutual agreement is in place.

A zoning update was questioned with a reply that County Commissioners are within weeks of releasing more information.

Regarding Twp planning Mr Vensil noted he is working on maps for the purpose of road maintenance and ditching.

A sample driveway permit was reviewed and discussed but agreed to table a decision until the March meeting.

Mr. Guthrie questioned the condition of Spencer Rd and the possibility of the county helping.

Mr Freas reported the backhoe was down with engine issues, Trustees advised calling Ross Agri for a diagnosis.

Mr Hunter has contacted a firm about township webpage development.
